# Business Partnerships

We are a nationally recognized expert in empowering students to succeed through mentoring, life skills development, goal setting, job readiness training, and career exploration.

## EVENT SPONSORSHIP

- **Golf Classic:** Held at Indianwood Country Club in September, this day on the links includes plenty of opportunities to meet and network with automotive industry leaders. This event draws 260 guests. Sponsorship ranges from \$700 to \$10,000.
- **Corks & Forks:** This special wine tasting and luxurious food experience is held in February at The Townsend Hotel in Birmingham. The event draws 300 guests. Sponsorship ranges from \$1,300 to \$15,000.

## ANNUAL PROGRAM SPONSORSHIP

Fund the cost of a student in our Workforce Prep program. The annual cost per student is \$2,000.

- Sponsorship ranges from \$1,000 to \$50,000 and includes promotion throughout the year. Some levels also include Golf Classic and Corks & Forks tickets and sponsorships.

## VOLUNTEER

- **Scholarship Judging:** Help us choose scholarship recipients by interviewing students or judging their application essays.

- **Career Plan Pitches:** Listen to students give their five-minute career presentation, ask questions, and coach through constructive feedback.
- **Job Experience Fair:** Teach students about specific careers by hosting a 30-minute hands-on simulation activity that directly relates to a job at your company.
- **Mentoring:** Mentor three to four students in our structured, evidence-based Workforce Prep program.
- **Workforce Prep Networking Mixer:** Talk one-on-one with students about your career path while asking them about their professional interests and goals.
